

## City Council Meeting

### Minutes

June 2, 2025

Mayor Cox called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM. Followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Council Members present: Dave Houston, Braden Meyers, Terry Tyler, Ricky Yeager, and Georgia Eggleston.

Mayor Cox requested approval of the proposed agenda for June 2. Yeager moved to accept the June 2 meeting agenda. Tyler second. Motion passed 5/0.

Mayor Cox recommended approving the minutes from the City Council Meeting held on May 5, 2025. Yeager suggested amending the voting results from the previous meeting to reflect a 3-0 vote, as the new council members were not formally elected until late in the May meeting. Additionally, the council needed to revote the motion to allocate \$250.00 to Southern Coffey County Elementary for their play day, as Mr. Houston had initially made the motion before the new council members were in place to vote on it. The mayor then requested a motion to approve these changes to the minutes. Yeager moved to accept the minutes with the proposed changes, and Tyler second. The motion passed with a unanimous vote of 5-0.

Mayor Cox requested the approval of the city council minutes from the special meeting held on May 19. Eggleston moved, and Houston seconded. The motion passed with a vote of 5 to 0.

Mayor Cox proposed the approval of the warrants and bills listed in the agenda. Tyler moved to accept the warrants and bills, and Meyers second. The motion passed with a vote of 5 to 0.

Cara Mays is representing the Smoke on the River event, scheduled for August 30 at Kelley Park in Burlington. She approached the council to discuss potential sponsorship for the event.

Mikel Duffy is planning to move a tiny house to 701 12th Street. The house will be placed on a concrete foundation and will have a tin exterior with a tin roof. The mayor and council have informed Mr. Duffy that before any work can begin on the sewer or water connections, he must obtain signatures from the residents living within 250 feet of the property line.
